IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TOURNAMENT REFUND POLICY

- The tournament has fixed expenses relating to field rental & facilities, staging and set-up costs, insurance, personnel and other matters regardless of cancelation due to weather or other reasons. Accordingly, teams will not receive a full credit of the entry fee if the tournament is canceled.
- If tournament is cancelled prior to the start of the event, the team will receive an 80% refund of the entry fee.
- If a team plays one (1) game and the rest are rained out, the team will receive a 50% refund of the entry fee.
- If a team plays two (2) or more games, the team will not receive a refund.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

- Each team will play at least four (4) games over the weekend, pending the weather.
- Teams will play round-robin style on Saturday and single-elimination playoffs will take place on Sunday.
- Seeding for playoffs on Sunday will be determined in the following sequential manner:
 - 1 Best Record
 - 2 Head-to-head
 - 3 Goal Differential
 - 4 Goals Against
 - 5 Goals For

Officials and Tournament Directors have final say on interpretations and rulings. Any questions regarding rules can be directed at the Tournament Directors in the Penberthy Front Office.



2023 Aggieland Classic Rules

PENALTIES

Penalties will be called and enforced according to each division's regular league rules with the following exceptions.

All time serving fouls are 1.5 x standard. A Technical Foul of 30 secs. will equal 45 secs., etc. Penalty time will only start when play resumes. (*example: Team A commits a time serving foul and calls timeout. Penalty time does not start until play resumes.*) A penalty on a goalie may be served by the in-home player.

Ejection Fouls result in automatic expulsion from existing game and next game. This applies for fighting and any foul that warrants ejection, unless allowed by tournament officials.

Aggressive body checks beyond necessity will not be tolerated. At the referee's discretion a player is subject to ejection for unnecessary roughness.

Individuals and teams in attendance are subject to disqualification from the tournament for disorderly conduct. No refund will be provided in the event of a team disqualification.

Officials and Tournament Directors are the authority on interpretations and rulings. All questions regarding rules should be directed to the tournament directors at the Penberthy Front Office.

The on-field referee may use his discretion in the enforcement of any rule not explicitly outlined above.

High School, 7/8, 5/6

GAME TIME	20 min running halves 5 min Halftime 1 Timeout Per Team, Per Half @ 1 min. No timeouts in last 2 minutes of each half 5 min Overtime (running clock, sudden victory) All overtimes begin with a faceoff
SUBSTITUTION	There is no horn substitution. All substitution rules will be on the fly.
CLEARING	4 second goalie counts will be in effect for all divisions. Clearing team will have 30 seconds to advance ball to offensive box.
PENALTY TIME	All time serving fouls are 1.5 x standard. A Technical Foul of 30 secs. will equal 45 secs. etc... Penalty time will only start when play resumes. (<i>example: Team A commits a time serving foul and calls timeout. Penalty time does not start until play resumes.</i>) A penalty on a goalie may be served by the in-home player.
EJECTION FOULS	Automatic expulsion from existing game and next game. This applies for fighting and any foul that warrants ejection. If ejected, the player will not be allowed to play the next game, unless allowed by tournament officials.
EQUIPMENT	All players must conform to standard league equipment rules including mouthpiece, shoulder pads, etc. There are no random stick or equipment checks by the Officials. Coaches may request a check but not in the last 2 minutes of each half.

The referee on the field may use his discretion in the event of any rule not mentioned.



2023 AGGIELAND CLASSIC RULES

3RD/4TH GRADE

PLAYERS	<p>7 players on field per team (2) Attackmen (2) Midfielders (2) Defensemen (1) Goalie</p> <p>Two long sticks allowed on the field simultaneously.</p>
FIELD	<p>Overall dimension: 60yd x 40 yd See Figure 1 for field dimensions</p>
FACE-OFF	<p>Each game half will begin with a face-off. The other pair of midfielders will start with their foot on the out-of-bounds line at mid-field.</p>
OFFSIDES	<p>Three (3) players must remain in their team's defensive half of the field and two (2) players must remain in their team's offensive half.</p>
GAME TIME	<p>20 min running halves 5 min Halftime 1 Timeout Per Team, Per Half @ 1 min. No timeouts in last 2 minutes of each half 5 min Overtime (running clock, sudden victory) All overtimes begin with a faceoff</p>
SUBSTITUTION	<p>There is no horn substitution. All substitution rules will be on the fly.</p>
CLEARING	<p>4 second goalie counts will be in effect for all divisions. Clearing team will have 30 seconds to advance ball to offensive box.</p>
PENALTIES	<p>All penalties will result in a 5 v. 4 fast break opportunity originating at the midfield line. Play will begin on the referee's whistle. Any player on field at the time of the foul may start with the ball. Neither team is allowed to substitute in the result of a penalty, with the exception of injury.</p>
EJECTION FOULS	<p>Automatic expulsion from existing game and next game. This applies for fighting and any foul that warrants ejection. If ejected,</p>



the player will not be allowed to play the next game, unless allowed by tournament officials.

EQUIPMENT

All players must conform to standard league equipment rules including mouthpiece, shoulder pads, etc. There are no random stick or equipment checks by the Officials. Coaches may request a check but not in the last 2 minutes of each half.

PLAYERS WILL BE ALLOWED TO USE LONG STICKS.
